Requirements

Essential Duties

1. Assist in providing services for students identified with Speech Language Impairments in the school setting under the direct supervision of a certified Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP).
2. Serve as a member of the educational team by consulting and collaborating with Supervising SLP, school staff, and Special Education team regarding services to students.
3. Meet regularly with SLP in order to coordinate services, maintain timely documentation of services, update student information, and design therapy materials for intervention.
4. Maintain professional certifications
