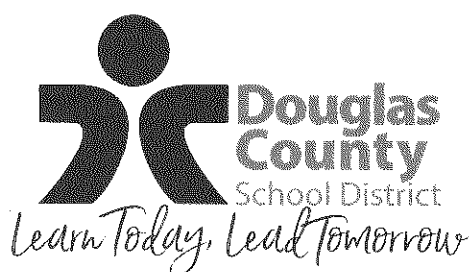
2018 **Mill Levy Override** and **Bond** Proposal

The Douglas County School District's Board of Education recently voted to place a **\$40 million Mill Levy Override (MLO)** and **\$250 million no-new-taxes Bond** on the ballot this fall.

If passed by voters, this is how the additional funds would be invested in our school.

Mill Levy Override and **Bond** Dollars would be used to:

- **Provide more competitive pay for teachers and staff**
- **Enhance safety and security systems**
- **Provide additional student mental health and wellness supports**
- **Expand academic programming**
- **Address urgent capital repairs, as allowed by Colorado state law**
