To Parents, Staff, and Clients of Parker Core Knowledge,

This letter is to inform you of the school's compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), administered by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and implemented by the Colorado Department of Public Health and the Environment. This law relates to asbestos in school buildings and its purpose is to assure building occupants that any asbestos-containing material that may be present in the building are kept in a "safe, undamaged" condition.

Under AHERA, each school is required to keep a copy of its "Asbestos Management Plan" on file, and this plan must be available for public viewing. In addition, the school must provide all building occupants (both staff and students) with annual notification as to each of the following: (1) what is being done in the building with regard to asbestos, and (2) availability of the "Asbestos Management Plan."

It is therefore the intent of this letter to inform you that no asbestos products were used in the construction of Parker Core Knowledge Charter School, 11661 Pine Drive, Parker, CO. Further, it is the intention of Parker Core Knowledge Charter School to keep the building free from asbestos-containing materials.

The public is advised that the "Asbestos Management Plan" is available for viewing during normal school hours at the school's business office.
