Operating Council Considerations

Elections are held yearly on the 3rd Tuesday of April. Each year 3 council members are elected to a two-year term.

When considering the opportunity to run for a seat on the PCKCS Operating Council, please use the following questions to assess how prepared you might be for the responsibilities of the position:

1. Are you the natural parent or legal guardian of a PCKCS student?
2. Have you been a part of the PCKCS community for at least one full school year?
3. Are you relatively familiar with the school operations; have you attended school events; do you have a sense of the school experience e.g. of possible operations?

If you answered 'Yes' to the first three questions, please consider the following:

1. Can you commit to one, possibly two, three-hour evening meetings per month?
2. Do you love this school and have a strong desire to help us maintain our strong reputation for academic excellence?
3. Do you have the ability to evaluate ideas/issues objectively and make decisions decisively?
4. Do you have a particular/specialized skill that you think might benefit the OC?

If you answered 'Yes' to the last four questions, consider yourself a qualified candidate for OC. If you were unable to answer 'Yes' to one or more of the questions above, please carefully consider whether an OC position is a good fit for you *at this time*.
